Phonics

We have changed our phonics scheme to Read, Write Inc., to align with Forward As One Multi Academy Trust. The children have completed the first four weeks of work and next will be being assessed to place them in their new phonics groups. We will be collecting all reading books in on Thursday and Friday, ready for the new books that match Read, Write Inc. phonics. These will start going out the following week.

Parents of children in reception, year 1, year 2 and some year 3 children will be given a leaflet explaining how the new scheme works. Links to additional support for parents will be posted on the school website.

We will be holding a workshop for parents in due course to explain the new scheme.

Parent's Evenings

Our first parent's evenings of the school year will be held the second week back after the half term holiday.

We operate a booking system via school spider. You will be notified when the booking tool will be open. Please ensure that you have access to the app, as you need it to make the booking.
