This half term we are focusing on 'Forgiveness'. This week we focused on Mother Sunday and the act of Mary anointing Jesus with perfume.

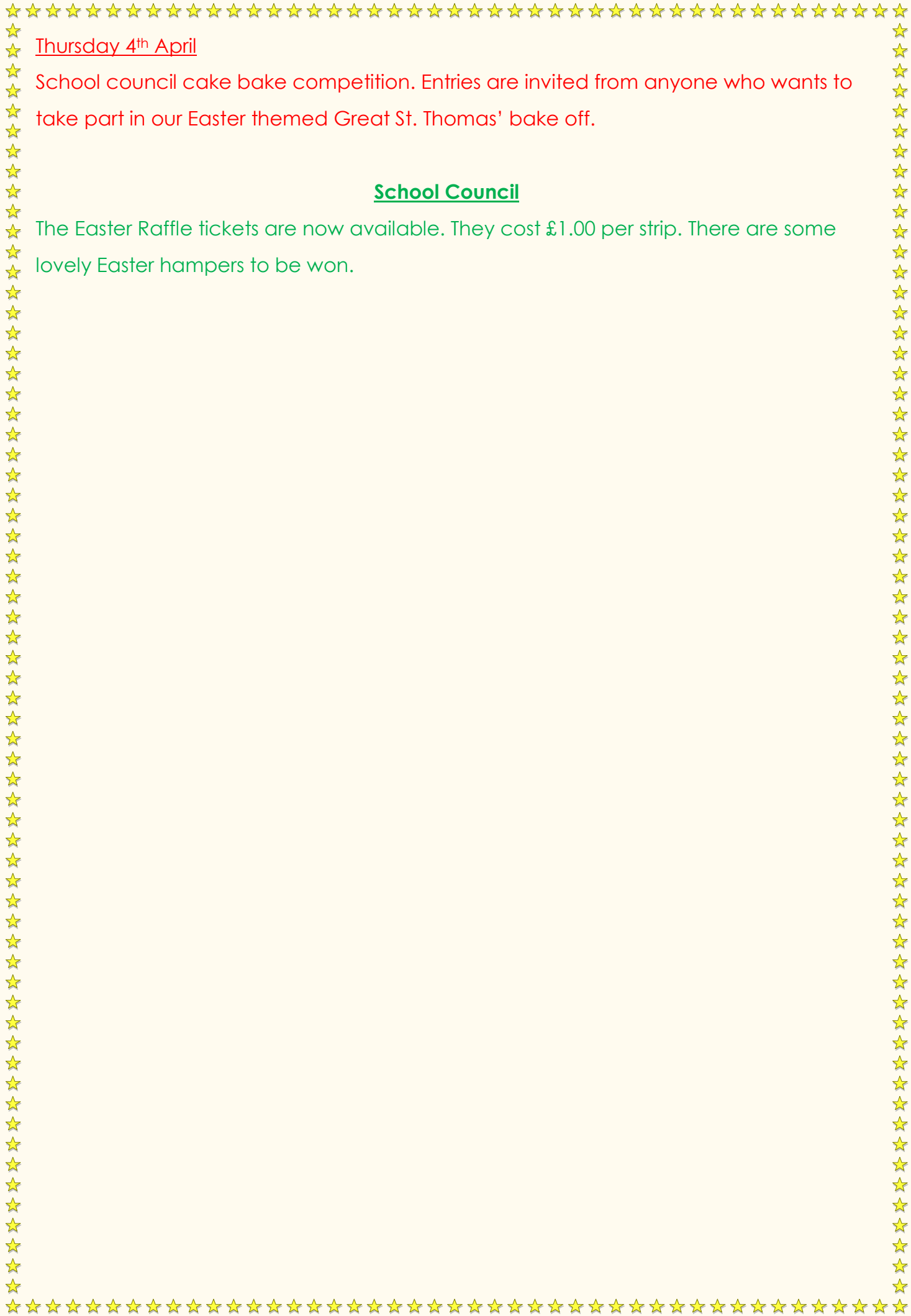
Easter events
