Class 2 – 97.5%

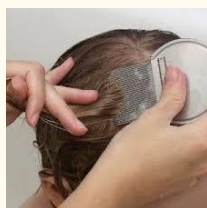
Class 4 – 98.33%

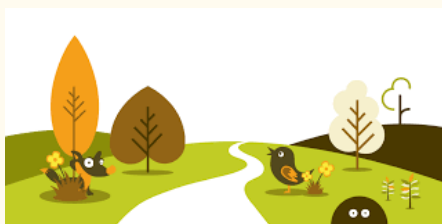
