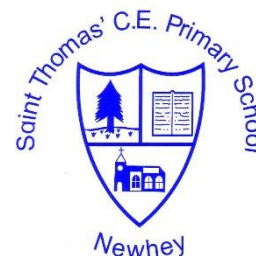

Reading at Home

(This is American – but it still applies)

Listening to your child read is crucial to their development and education. It is also crucial that children hear you read to them – particularly younger children. Many of our children struggle to understand the required vocabulary because they are not hearing and using it regularly.
